
Report of Singapore Study Tour

Through technologies of Rainwater Harvesting, Sewage Water Treatment and Building Artificial Reservoirs in the City, the New Water Plant Sources and conserves all of the water and purifies it through Reverse Osmosis, techniques of Ultra filtration and Ultraviolet Disinfection and makes it accessible to the entire population of the Singapore.
